Evaluation Process of Sediment Control Measures for Addition to Environmental Division's Approved Product List (APL) Construction Control Directive No. **20221024** 

## October 24, 2022

Scope: To establish a procedure for the evaluation of erosion control devices not covered by Section 221, and to validate the performance of these devices for use on all State Projects.

With the presence of the APL trial product plan note, the Engineer may select one device for use as a trial product from the list below. The Field District will need to coordinate with the Designer during the planning stage and the product will be denoted in the Erosion Control Detail Sheets for intended placement and use. If the product used does not function as intended, the Engineer may request in writing that an alternative device compliant with Section 221 be used. The Contractor will have 10 days to submit an alternative product and a schedule of when the compliant device will be installed.

The devices will be installed according to the Manufacture's recommendation in addition to direction from the Engineer.

Following the use of the product, the Engineer and Contractor will complete the form attached to this directive and submit to the Storm Water Action Team (SWAT). This will be submitted via email to <u>SWAT@odot.ok.gov</u>

If at least five evaluations indicate that the device used functions as required SWAT will recommend to Materials Division to include the device on Approved Products List.
