BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY CLEARANCE CONTRACTS
Project Specific**

These Special Provisions revise, amend, and where in conflict, supersede applicable sections of the 2009 Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, English and Metric.

(Add the following:)

102.17 BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY CLEARANCE CONTRACTS

While the overall bid for this project is Lump Sum, the low bidder must provide the Department with an individual dollar amount for each parcel to be cleared using the Clearance/Removal List provided in the bidding documents.

Furthermore, the Department requires that the Contractor provide evidence of possessing the necessary equipment, permits, licenses, certifications, etc. required to successfully and legally perform the work specified in the bidding documents prior to awarding the Contract to the successful bidder. In addition to the completed Clearance/Removal List described above, submit the Contractor's current NESHAP license/certification, and any other documents as requested elsewhere in these bidding documents, or as requested by the ODOT Right-of-Way Division. (Such requests for documents may be made after the opening of the bids for this project.)

The ODOT Right-of-Way Division will review the apparent low bidders' submittal(s) to determine compliance with the material requirements specified in the bidding documents. Submit a copy of the Clearance/Removal List and the Contractor's NESHAP license/certification to the ODOT Office Engineer Division with the bid, or no later than the Department's close of business on the Wednesday following the bid opening. If the form is not received by this time, or the Contractor refuses to provide the requested documents, then the Contractor's bid may be considered nonresponsive and be rejected by the Department in accordance with Subsection 102.14 of the Standard Specifications.
