

ENVIRONMENTAL MITIGATION NOTES:

CLIFF SWALLOWS & BARN SWALLOWS

CLIFF SWALLOWS AND BARN SWALLOWS ARE SMALL COLONIAL NESTING BIRDS PROTECTED BY THE FEDERAL MIGRATORY BIRD TREATY ACT. THESE SPECIES COMMONLY USE BRIDGES AND CULVERTS FOR NESTING. THE NESTING SEASON FOR THE SWALLOWS RUNS FROM APRIL 1 TO AUGUST 31. SWALLOW USE OF THE BRIDGES IN THIS PROJECT HAS BEEN OBSERVED. ANY ACTIVITIES WHICH WOULD DESTROY ACTIVE NESTS OR HARM EGGS OR BIRDS WOULD VIOLATE THE MIGRATORY BIRD TREATY ACT. THE RESIDENT ENGINEER WILL EVALUATE THE CONTRACTOR'S PROPOSED WORK METHODS AND CONCLUDE WHETHER THE PROPOSED WORK WOULD HARM THE NESTING BIRDS BEFORE WORK NEAR THE STRUCTURE IS AUTHORIZED. IF THE PROPOSED WORK WILL HARM THE NESTING BIRDS, THE BRIDGE MAY BE NETTED PRIOR TO APRIL 1 OR THE WORK DELAYED UNTIL THE NESTING SEASON IS COMPLETE. METHODS OTHER THAN NETTING MUST BE PRE-APPROVED BY THE ODOT BIOLOGIST.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL NOTE

LOCATIONS OUTSIDE THE PROJECT AREA IN THE FOLLOWING AREA MUST NOT BE UTILIZED FOR BORROW, EQUIPMENT STAGING, HAUL ROADS, SPOIL DUMPS OR ANY OFF-SITE PROJECT-RELATED ACTIVITY.
