RIGHT-OF-WAY PROJECT LENGTH 0.77 MILES

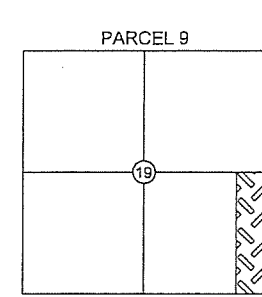
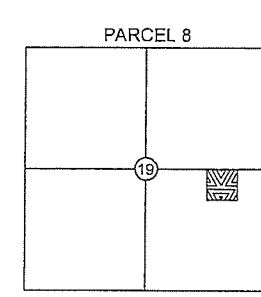
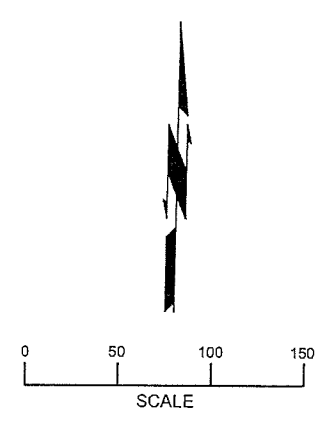
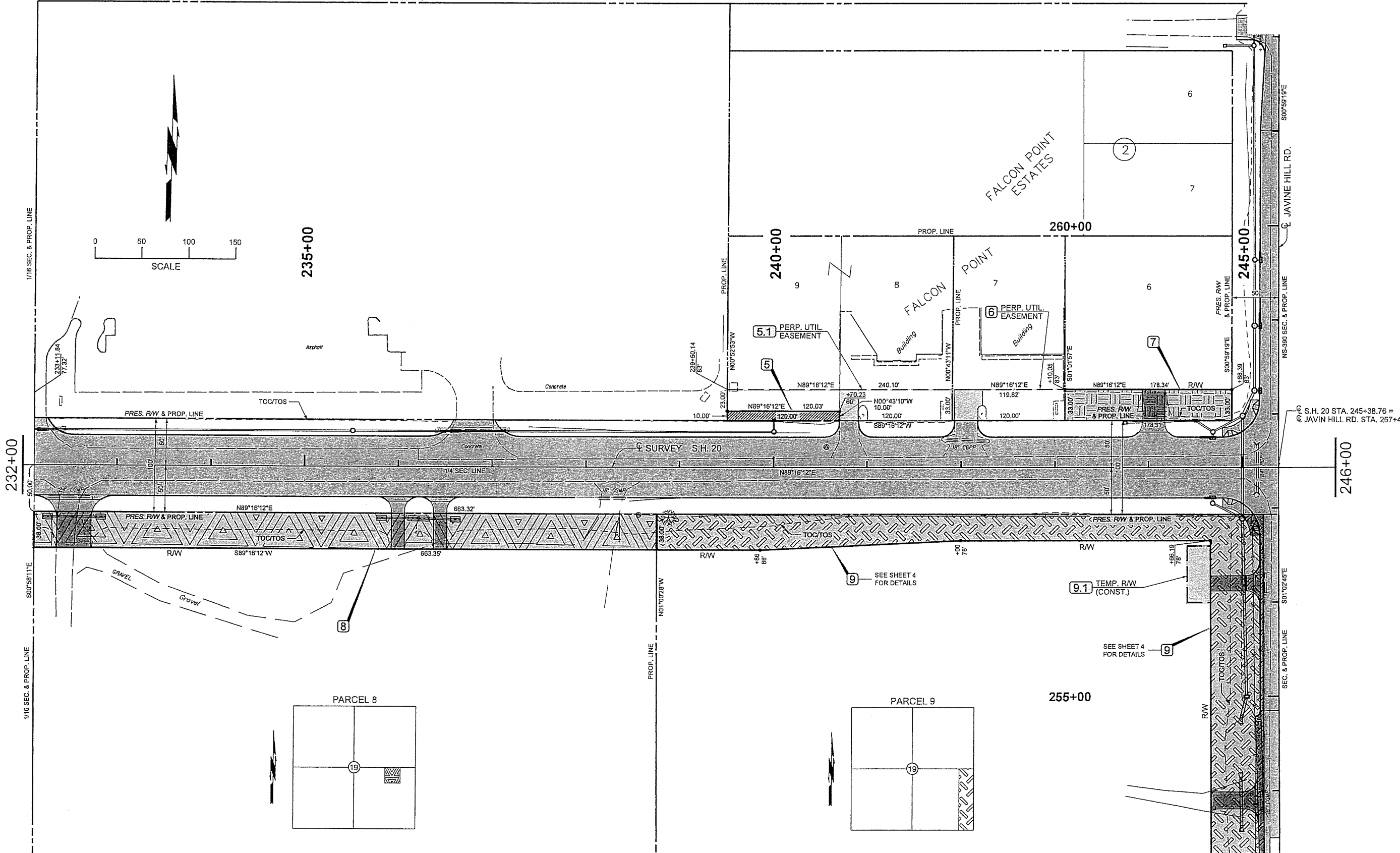
