(1) Notes for "Select Borrow":

- 1.1) Should any outside material be needed to be brought in from outside the project, unless there is an applicable pay item for it, payment for such borrow shall be by the item for "Select Borrow". The borrow shall be acceptable to the Engineer for the use intended (i.e., topsoil, subgrade, etc.)

(2) Notes for "Earthwork":

- 2.1) The pay item for "Earthwork" includes all dirt operations for which specific pay items are not provided, for example:

- Blading and windrowing existing topsoil to prepare for new construction. Such topsoil may need to be transported within project limits to temporary stockpile sites.
- Placing topsoil back over exposed areas after construction.
- At the designated roadway widening areas, benching and compacting the subgrade using good-faith compaction efforts acceptable to the Engineer. Should the subgrade need stabilizing, separate pay items have been provided for "Stabilized Subgrade".
- Working any borrow that has to be brought in.
- Hauling dirt within the project limits, from areas of excess to where needed, or to temporary storage piles.
- Ultimately hauling away any waste dirt (if any). Waste shall become property of the contractor.
- Mucking out unacceptable subgrade material.
- Excavation needed to form up and pour new curb & gutter, drives, valley gutters, sidewalks.
- During removal of concrete and asphalt (e.g., rebuilding a sidewalk apron), further excavation may be needed to get done to the new subgrade, if the existing pavement is thin.

- 2.2) Any ultimate wastage from project operations shall become property of the Contractor and removed from the job site.
