



(\*) Actual number of posts will vary with site. The intent is for the post spacing to be uniform.

(\*) The length extension shall conform to the 12" minimum requirement illustrated in the insert.

NOTE: Per the "Proposed Accessibility Guidelines For Pedestrian Facilities in the Public Right-of-Way", July 26, 2011, published by the United States Access Board, the height of the railing shall be between 34" and 38", with the bottom railing preventing passage of a 4" sphere. They do not require a middle railing. This project is specifying a railing height of 36", with the bottom rail to be 4" from center-of-rail to the concrete. This project is also requiring a middle placed approx. 22" above the concrete.
