- XII. EXISTING RIGHT OF WAY

The right-of-way along U.S. 270 and S.H. 51 was established from the existing plans, right-of-way documents, and right-of-way occupation. Existing right-of-way, easements, and property ownerships for this survey were obtained from deeds on file at the Dewey County Court House and the ODOT Right-of-Way Division, Engineering Branch.

XIII. UTILITIES

There are several underground utilities within the project extents. CALL OKTE was contacted on March 31, 2011 with Order No. 110331090385, 1103310910392, 11033109120402, 11033109180401, 110331091040416, 11033109120456. After being contacted additional times, the lines were flagged and painted. A telecommunications schematic provided by Pioneer Telephone Cooperative was used to plot existing fiber optic lines. In addition, overhead utility lines run generally parallel with the existing roadway. All are depicted in the submitted digital file.
