- 77. SE Corner of Section 26 - Found and accepted a #4 bar with "PLS 1444" cap. Location is in agreement with OCCR filed in 2010 and 2004 and is in harmony with existing improvements. The reference monuments were found and verified.
- 78. W/4 Corner of Section 35 - Set a #4 bar with "CA 2054" cap for corner. Location was re-established to be in agreement with existing improvements. Also found a #4 bar with "1737 OK" but did not accept location because of the method in which it was set and it did not fit surrounding improvements.
- 79. Center of Section 35 - Computed only.
- 80. E/4 Corner of Section 35 - Found and accepted a #4 bar with "1737 OK" cap. Location is in agreement with OCCR filed in 2010. The reference monuments were found and verified. The monument referenced in OCCR filed in 2002 was not found.
- 81. SW Corner of Section 35 - Found and accepted a #4 bar. Location is in agreement with OCCR filed in 1995. Three reference monuments were found and verified.
- 82. S/4 Corner of Section 35 - Found and accepted a #4 bar. Location is in agreement with OCCR filed in 2010. The reference monuments were found and verified.
- 83. SE Corner of Section 35 - Found and accepted a #4 bar. Location is in agreement with OCCR filed in 2010, 2002, and 1994 and is in harmony with existing improvements. The reference monuments were found and verified.

XII. EXISTING RIGHT OF WAY

The right-of-way along U.S. 270 and S.H. 51 was established from the existing plans, right-of-way documents, and right-of-way occupation. Existing right-of-way, easements, and property ownerships for this survey were obtained from deeds on file at the Dewey County Court House and the ODOT Right-of-Way Division, Engineering Branch.

XIII. UTILITIES

There are several underground utilities within the project extents. CALL ORTE was contacted on March 31, 2011 with Order No. 11033109090385, 11033109100392, 11033109120402, 11033109130409, 11033109140416, 11033109150424, 11033109170435, 11033109180441, 11033109190448, and 11033109210456. After being contacted additional times, the lines were flagged and painted. A telecommunications schematic provided by Pioneer Telephone Cooperative was used to plot existing fiber optic lines. In addition, overhead utility lines run generally parallel with the existing roadway. All are depicted in the submitted digital file.

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XIV. HAZARDOUS WASTE

During the performance of required conventional survey work, survey crew members watched for areas/sites that could have previously or are now being used to store or dispose of possible contaminants. None were found.

XV. DRAINAGE INFORMATION

- A. Drainage areas for all drains crossing the Survey Centerline were taken from USGS quad maps that have been scanned into a Microstation Design File. These areas (divide lines), where possible, were field checked for accuracy prior to submittal of the project.
- B. There was no visible evidence of a high water mark.
