

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received in the Office of the Ottawa County Clerk, Reba G. Sill, at 102 East Central Avenue, Suite 103 in Miami, Oklahoma 74354, until 9:15 AM on October 11, 2010. Bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud by the Board of County Commissioners on the following:

SOUTH 630 ROAD PAVING PROJECT

With Three Options

PROJECT: Paving approximately 1 mile with 2.5" to 3" Type B compacted asphalt overlay @ 20 ft wide

LOCATION: Beginning on South 630 Road at the intersection of East 30 Road, then south approximately one mile to the intersection of East 40 Road

OPTION ONE: TURN-KEY OPERATION

Contractor to provide, haul, lay and roll asphalt with tack oil
Bid MUST include estimated total tonnage and price per ton laid in place

OPTION TWO: COUNTY TO PROVIDE HAULING

Contractor to provide, lay and roll asphalt with tack oil
Bid MUST include estimated total tonnage and price per ton laid in place

OPTION THREE: COUNTY TO PROVIDE AND HAUL ASPHALT

Contractor to provide tack oil, lay and roll asphalt (provided by the County) with tack oil
Bid MUST include estimated total tonnage and price per ton laid in place

All work performed must meet Oklahoma Department of Transportation specifications, under the direction of Ottawa County Commissioner John Clarke.

All material used must meet current Oklahoma Department of Transportation specifications, with Mix-Design to be submitted by the successful Bidder at least ten (10) days prior to beginning Project.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Prospective Bidders will be **required** to attend a **Pre-Bid Conference** at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, October 5 at the intersection of South 630 and East 30 Roads for more specific instructions.

Bids submitted must be clearly marked on front of a sealed envelope:

Firm prices will be FOB Ottawa County.

Purchases by Ottawa County, Oklahoma are not subject to State or Federal taxes.

This Bid is submitted as legal offer and any Bid, when accepted by the County, constitutes a firm Contract.

Oklahoma laws require each vendor submitting a Bid to a County for goods or services to furnish a notarized sworn Statement of Non-Collusion (**form supplied below**).

NOTE: Other terms and conditions may be added at the discretion of County Officers.

STATEMENT OF NON-COLLUSION

AFFIDAVIT: I, the undersigned, of lawful age, being first duly sworn on oath say that he (she) is the agent authorized by the bidder to submit the above bid. Affiant further states that the bidder has not been a party to any collusion among bidders in restraint of freedom of competition by agreement to bid at a fixed price or to refrain from bidding; or with any state official or employee as to quantity, quality or price in the prospective contract or any other terms of said prospective contract; or in any discussions between bidders and any state official concerning exchange of money or other thing of value for special consideration in the letting of a contract; that the bidder/contractor has not paid, given or donated or agreed to pay, give or donate to any officer or employee of the State of Oklahoma (or other entity) any money or other thing of value, either directly or indirectly, in the procuring of the award of a contract pursuant to this bid.
