

5. Purchases by Canadian County, Oklahoma, are not subject to state or federal taxes.
6. This bid is submitted as a legal offer and any bid when accepted by the County constitutes a firm contract.

Jensen Road Project / District #3

Canadian County District #3 is seeking bids for Jensen Road Project from Banner Road west 2 ½ miles.

Specifications:

Pay Quantity Notes

Prime coat shall be applied at an estimated rate of 0.35 gal. per sq. yd. when applied to subgrade, and 0.25 gal. per sq. yd. when applied to aggregate base. The actual cutback prime coat required for placement operations will be determined by the contractor, and shall consider the residue from distillation percentage shown in section 708.03 of the standard specifications.

- Always tied to 408 Prime Coat.

Asphalt estimated at 112 lbs per sq. yd per 1" thick.

Traffic control shall be in accordance with chapter VI of the current manual of uniform traffic control devices for streets and highways and the Oklahoma Department of Transportation standards.

Projects shall be constructed without closing road to local traffic.

The traffic control standard drop-off detail sheet be followed.

The contractor shall be responsible for temporary pavement markings. The temporary pavement markings shall consist of const. zone pavement markers (flex tab) type I [Davidson Plastics model T.O.M. or Stimsonite model 300 or approved equal] spaced 50 ft. c/c on centerline and 100 ft. c/c on edge lines. The cost will be included in other pay items.

All construction work zone signs and channelization shall have the fluorescent sheeting. The fluorescent sheeting shall meet all requirements of ASTM D4956-07 for type VIII.

The manufacture shall furnish a type 'A' certification in accordance with ODOT standard specification, 2009, subsection 106.04. The certification shall include test results on material submitted for approval.

All signs shall have a "like new" appearance (E.G., no faded lettering nor background). The backing material (E.G., plywood or sheeting material) shall not be damaged nor aged (E.G., debonding plywood). Likewise, sheeting strips engineer shall be replaced by the contractor without further debate.

General Construction Notes

Specifications: Comply with the requirements of the 2009 Oklahoma Standard Specifications for highway construction, except as modified by the plans and special provisions.

This project shall be constructed without closing the existing road to local traffic. See standard specifications for maintenance of local traffic.

This project shall be constructed without closing the existing section line roads to local and through traffic. See standard specifications for maintenance of local and through traffic.

In order to alleviate dust conditions during grading operations and before pavement work is completed, the contractor shall sprinkle grading at intervals approved by the engineer. All cost to be included in other items of work.

Surfacing of returns, unless otherwise shown on the plans, shall be of the same material (base and surface) as that of the abutting shoulder of the mainline. Base and surface thickness shall be the thickness shown on plans. Returns will be constructed to the right of way at Manning Rd., Evans Rd, and Banner Rd.

Bids will be received beginning at 9:30am on Tuesday, May 29, until 9:30am on Monday, June 4, 2018.

Bids shall be accompanied by:

- A certified check, cashier's check or bid bond equal to five percent (5%) of the bid, which shall be deposited with the awarding public agency as a guaranty; or

An irrevocable letter of credit terms the Construction and Properties Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services prescribes, issued by a financial institution insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or the Federal Savings and Loan Insurance Corporation for the benefit of the state, on behalf of the awarding public agency, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the bid. The awarding public agency shall deposit the irrevocable letter of credit with Division.

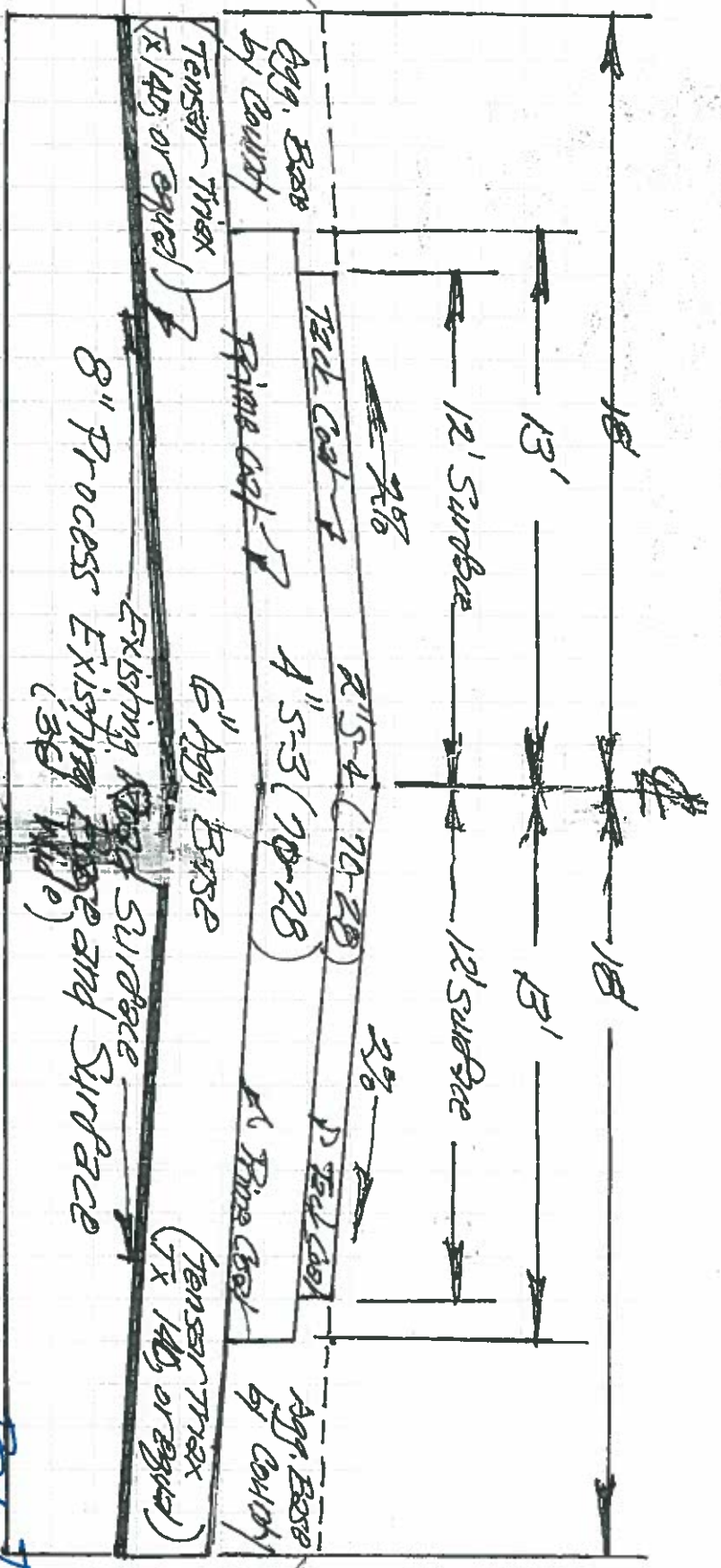

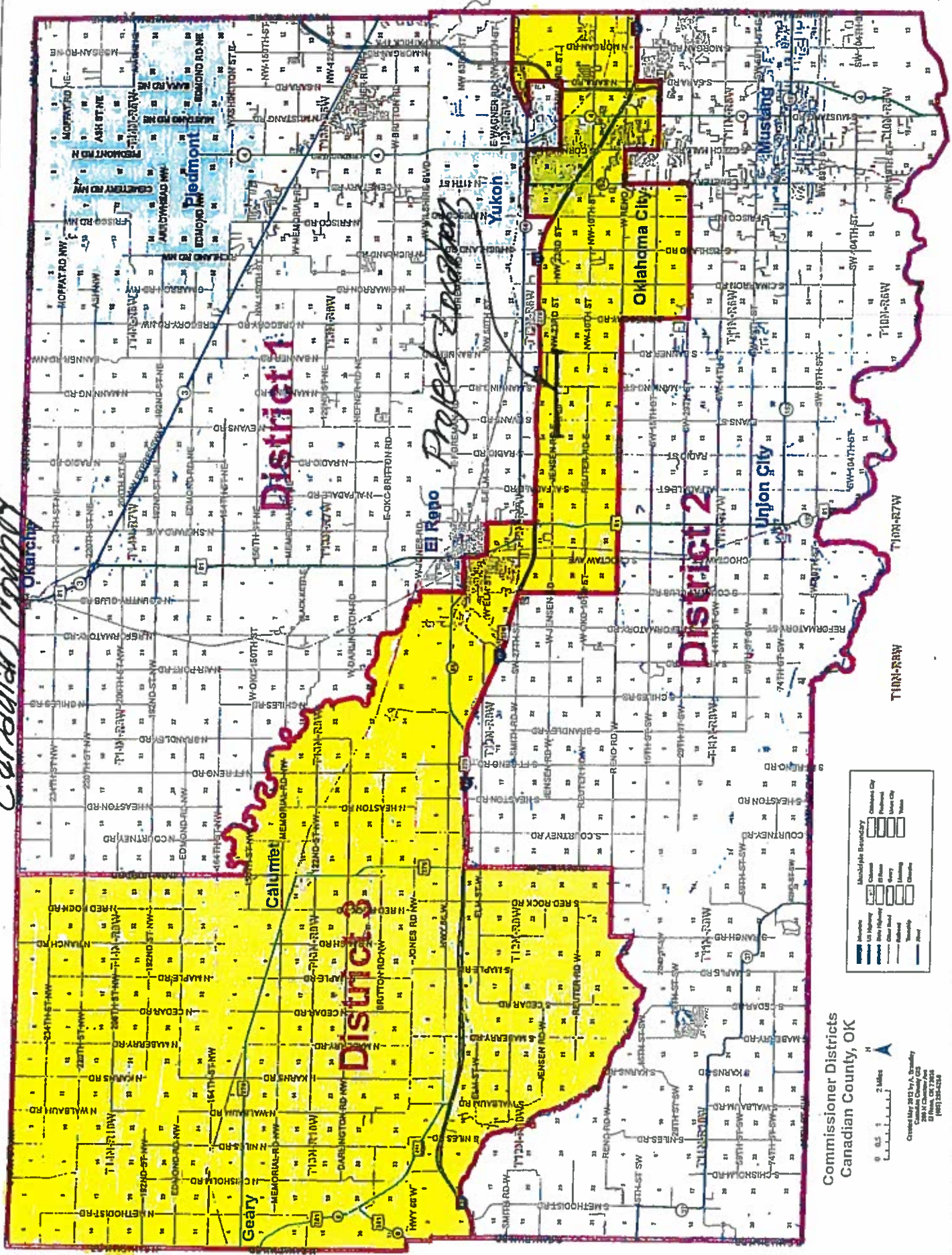
