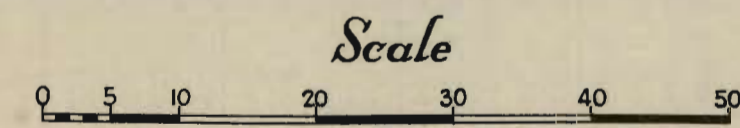

JULY-1-1931

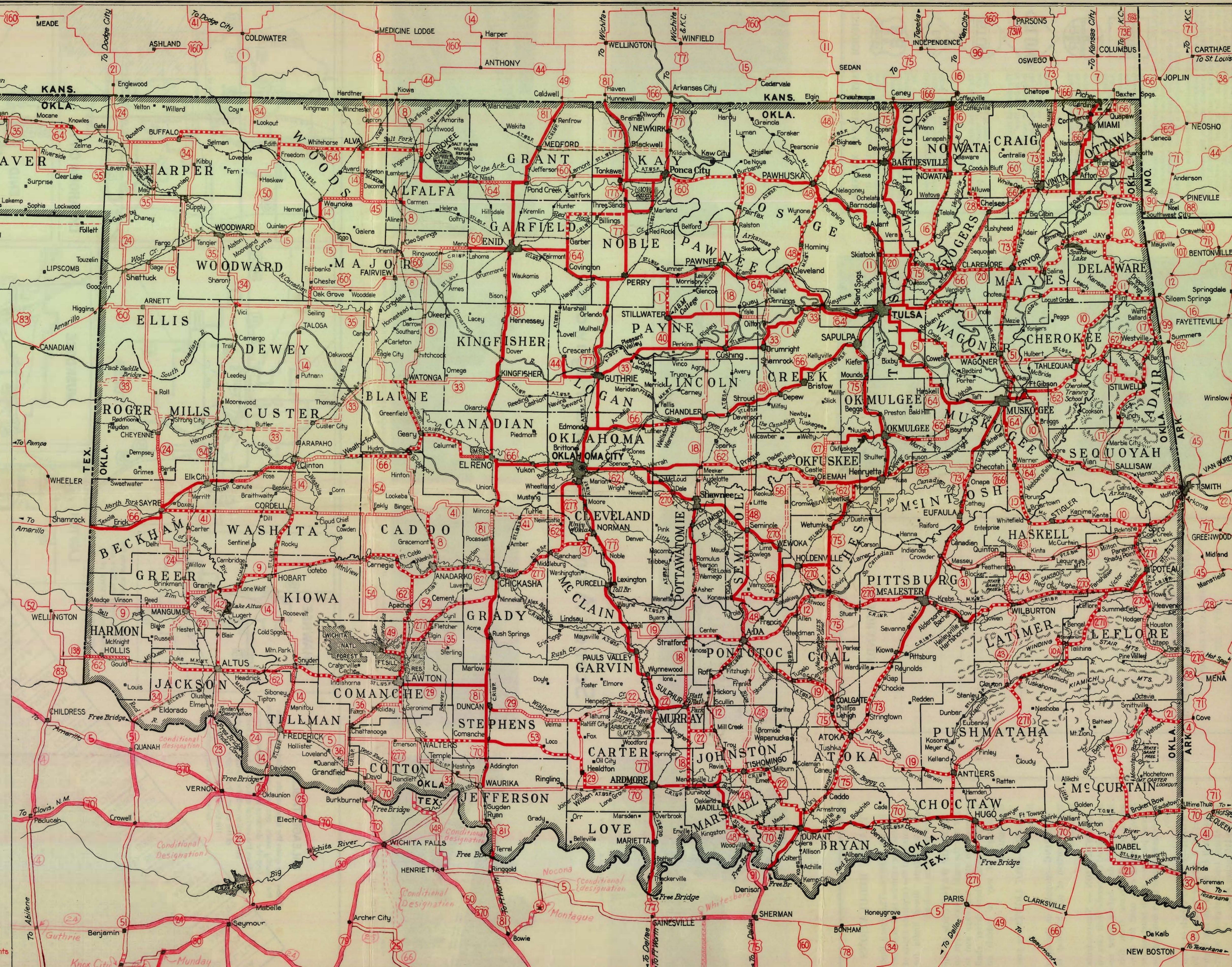
