## Project Information

The purpose of the proposed US 70 project is to provide a roadway facility to meet future transportation needs. US 70 is currently a two-lane highway with four-foot shoulders.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) undertook a Feasibility Study in 1997 which identified this segment of the roadway as an area of high crash rate and high priority for improvements.

Based on ODOT's further studies, this segment of US 70 is rated as "inadequate," and indicated deficiencies in design and condition of the roadway.

Traffic characteristics along this portion of US 70 consist of 20 percent heavy vehicles. The large percentage of heavy vehicles and restricted site distance limiting passing opportunities creates undesirable conditions on the current roadway facility.
