Welcome to the SH 48 Public Information Meeting. The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public of the Department's plans to replace the bridges on SH 48 over the Deep Fork of the North Canadian River in Okfuskee County. The Department's intent is to temporarily close this portion of SH 48 throughout the bridges replacement process in an attempt to expedite construction.

State Highway Facts

The SH 48 bridges were built in 1938.

In 1956 the Oklahoma Department of Transportation re-designated SH 27 to SH 48.

Purpose for Meeting

- Discuss status of the project with the public
- Provide detailed information regarding the design and construction of the project
- Share information and answer questions concerning the project

Project Information

- Estimated project cost \$7.2 million
- The Department is currently in the process of acquiring Right-of-Way
- Construction is scheduled to begin in Fall of 2009
- 180 to 200 total number of calendar days planned for the project
- This project has an incentive/disincentive of \$5,000 per day
- Project length 0.804 mile
- The bridges and roadway width will be two 12' driving lanes with 8' paved shoulders on each side
