THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING IS TO DISCUSS THE DEPARTMENT'S PROPOSED PLAN TO REALIGN S.H. 136 FROM THE OK STATE LINE, NORTH APPROXIMATELY 5 MILES TOWARD GUYMON, OK.



Information about the current Alignment

- Current ADT Value of 700 vehicles per day as of 2008.
- Projected ADT Value of 1000 vehicles per day as of 2028.
- Current State Highway has grass shoulders only.
- Current State Highway has a potential for accidents due to icy conditions in the winter.

Beginning of Proposed SH 136 Alignment


Looking north onto NS-86, just north of the Oklahoma State Line.

Local Business is very important to our communities here in the State of Oklahoma. Businesses, like pictured, will have better access to their site as well as a more safe route through the state.





Northern intersetion of S.H. 136 and NS-86




North end of proposed SH 136, looking South








Information about Proposed Alignment

- Removal of dangerous curves decreases the chances of accidents in icy weather during the winter months.
- Removal of dangerous curves would decrease drive time thru the project.
- New Alignment has the potential to increase tourism in Guymon because of safer travel.
- Old State Highway would be given to the county after a chip and seal surface restoration, for continued use and maintenance.
