

Traffic Information

- Current AADT (2010)
 - Approximately 10,000 near Poteau
 - Approximately 14,000 at north end
 - Approximately 21,000 on US 271 at north end
- Projected AADT (30 years)
 - Approximately 15,000 near Poteau
 - Approximately 24,000 at north end
 - Approximately 34,000 on US 271 at north end

Accident Information

- Five years of data will be used as part of improvement analysis
 - 2005 to 2009
 - 365 total collisions
 - 259 (70%) involved injury
