Public Meeting Scheduled for US-283

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is proposing to improve US-283 south of Altus in Jackson County, Oklahoma. The proposed improvements include the replacement of one bridge box with a span bridge, extending 3 bridge boxes and adding shoulders to the roadway to improve safety. The proposed improvements consist of two separate projects, the first begins 0.5 mile north of the Red River Bridge and extends north to the SH-5 Junction. The second project begins at SH-5 Junction, extending north 6.1 miles.

A public meeting to present the proposed project information and receive public input is scheduled for May 13, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. at the Southwest Technology Center, Seminar Center, 711 W. Tamarack, Altus, Oklahoma. The meeting will include a presentation about the proposed improvements to the highway including why the improvements are needed, the type of improvements proposed and the expected impacts to motorists and the surrounding community. The purpose of the meeting is to obtain input regarding social, economic, and environmental effects that may result from the proposed project.
