Welcome to The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) Public Meeting for S.H. 53 in Carter County, OK

PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING
The purpose of this meeting is to inform the public \& solicit comments about the Department's proposed projects to improve S.H. 53 from 5.5 Miles East of S.H. 76 (Fox Junction) to Fitzgerald Rd.

PURPOSE OF THIS PROJECT
The purpose of these projects are to improve the safety of S.H. 53 by reconstructing the highway on an offset alignment, adding paved shoulders, and reconstructing the bridges \& drainage structures along the identified facility.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHW A) is proposing to improve SH-53 West of Ardmore in Carter County, OK. The proposed improvements include the reconstruction of SH-53 beginning 5.5 miles East of SH76 (Fox Junction) continuing for approx. 9.37 miles with added 8 ' paved shoulders \& the reconstruction of 8 bridges. The proposed improvements consist of two separate projects; the West project (Caddo Creek Bridge) begins 5.5 miles East of $\mathrm{SH}-76$ \& extends East for 1.37 miles, the East project begins 6.87 miles East of SH-76, extending East for 8.0 miles.


TYPICAL BRIDGE REPLACEMENT
A 2-Lane undivided roadway running across a creek / river / other roadway.

PROJECT INFORMATION

- Estimated Total Cost of these projects is $\$ 35.5$ Million
- Right-of-Way and Utility Relocation started in 2011
- Construction on the Caddo Creek project estimated to start in 2013
- Construction on the East Project estimated to start in 2015
- Reconstruction of the highway facility with 2-12' lanes \& 8' paved shoulders
- Projects to be constructed under traffic (no road closure)
- Current ADT (Average Daily Traffic) $=1400$ vehicles a day
- Future estimated ADT $=1800$ vehicles a day
