Public Input Needed on Proposed Bicycle/Pedestrian Access for Eastbound I-244/ Arkansas River Bridge

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation is seeking public input on a revised design concept for the bicycle/pedestrian facility on the eastbound I-244 bridge over the Arkansas River in Tulsa. This bridge is scheduled for replacement in FFY 2013.

The current proposal shows a pedestrian bridge spanning the entire length of the eastbound I-244 bridge. Public comments are needed on a revised proposal, which would replace the pedestrian bridge with a viewing platform area instead on the north side of the bridge. This would provide a scenic view of the historic Cyrus Avery Route 66 Memorial Bridge and be located near the future Route 66 history center. The revised proposal would also connect this platform via a trail to the pedestrian/bicycle facility on the westbound I-244 bridge, which is currently under construction.
