

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is proposing to improve a section of State Highway 8 from Cyril extending north approximately 9 miles to a point slightly north of the EW 138 section road, which lacks shoulders, has areas of limited sight distance and contains two sharp curves.

ODOT has tasked a Consultant to study several alternatives to improve this section of State Highway 8 while taking into consideration construction costs, traffic analysis, utility impacts, oil and gas well impacts and environmental constraints. The purpose of the meeting is to present these alternatives and solicit comments relevant to the Department's proposed improvement to this section of State Highway 8.
