KANSAS-OKLAHOMA: The extension of US 169 from Kansas City, Missouri, over State Route 16 in Kansas and State Route 16 in Oklahoma, terminating at Tulsa, Oklahoma. It is the understanding that as soon as Kansas completes a direct route in that State between the towns of Garnett and Erie that US 59 will be transferred to this direct route between these two points instead of following the route now indicated, which will then be a part only of US 169.
