US Highway 169 and State Highway 10 Revision - Nowata County

Transfer from the State Highway System a segment of old road designated as US Highway 169 beginning at its junction with State Highway 10 in Lenapah and extending northerly to its junction with the new location, a distance of 5.6 miles. This segment of old road will be transferred to Nowata County or the City of Lenapah for further maintenance or abandonment.

Add US 169 temporary designation on State Highway 10 beginning at its junction with the old location of US Highway 169 in Lenapah and extending east to its junction with the new location of US Highway 169 east of Lenapah, a distance of 0.4 mile.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new road to be designated as US Highway 169 beginning at its junction with State Highway 10 east of Lenapah and extending north to its junction with the old location, a distance of 5.4 miles.

This revision to the State Highway System will become effective upon the completion of construction of Federal-aid Primary Project F-193(10)(11).

The Oklahoma State Highway Commission in regular session December 1, 1969, Item 273b, approved the following revision in the State Highway System:

US 169 and State Highway 10 Revision - Nowata County

Transfer from the State Highway system a segment of old road designated as US 169 beginning at its junction with SH 10 in Lenapah and extending northerly to its junction with the new location, a distance of 5.6 miles. This segment of old road will be transferred to Nowata County or the City of Lenapah for further maintenance or abandonment.

Add US 169 temporary designation on SH 10 beginning at its junction with the old location of US 169 in Lenapah and extending east to its junction with the new location of US 169 east of Lenapah, a distance of 0.4 mile.

Add to the State Highway system a segment of new road to be designated as US 169 beginning at its junction with SH 10 east of Lenapah and extending north to its junction with the old location, a distance of 5.4 miles.

This revision to the State Highway system will become effective upon the completion of construction of Federal-aid Primary Project F-193(10)(11).

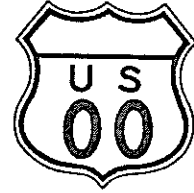

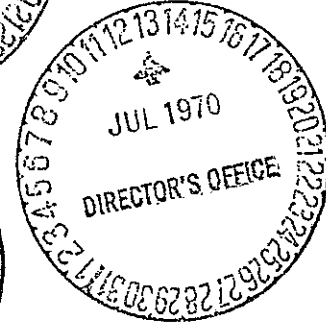
