SUBJECT: State Highway System Revision -
Relocation US 177 south of
Ponca City

COUNTY: Kay

This item is necessitated by the proposed relocation of US 177 south of Ponca City, Kay County. Construction Project STP-036B(259).

Add to the State Highway System upon **completion of construction**, a segment of a new highway to be designated US 177, beginning at a tie with the existing facility in Section 3, T25N, R2E and extending northeasterly .75 mile to a junction with US 60 and US 77 at the southeast edge of Ponca City.

Remove from the State Highway System .64 mile of old highway replaced by the new construction. This section of previous US 177 will be transferred to the appropriate local jurisdiction for further maintenance or abandonment. A Public Removal Hearing was held February 6, 1995, in compliance with state law.

This revision to the State Highway System will become effective upon approval by the State Transportation Commission and **completion of construction** of US 177 on new alignment. Letting of this project is scheduled for February, 1997.

The Department recommends approval of this item.

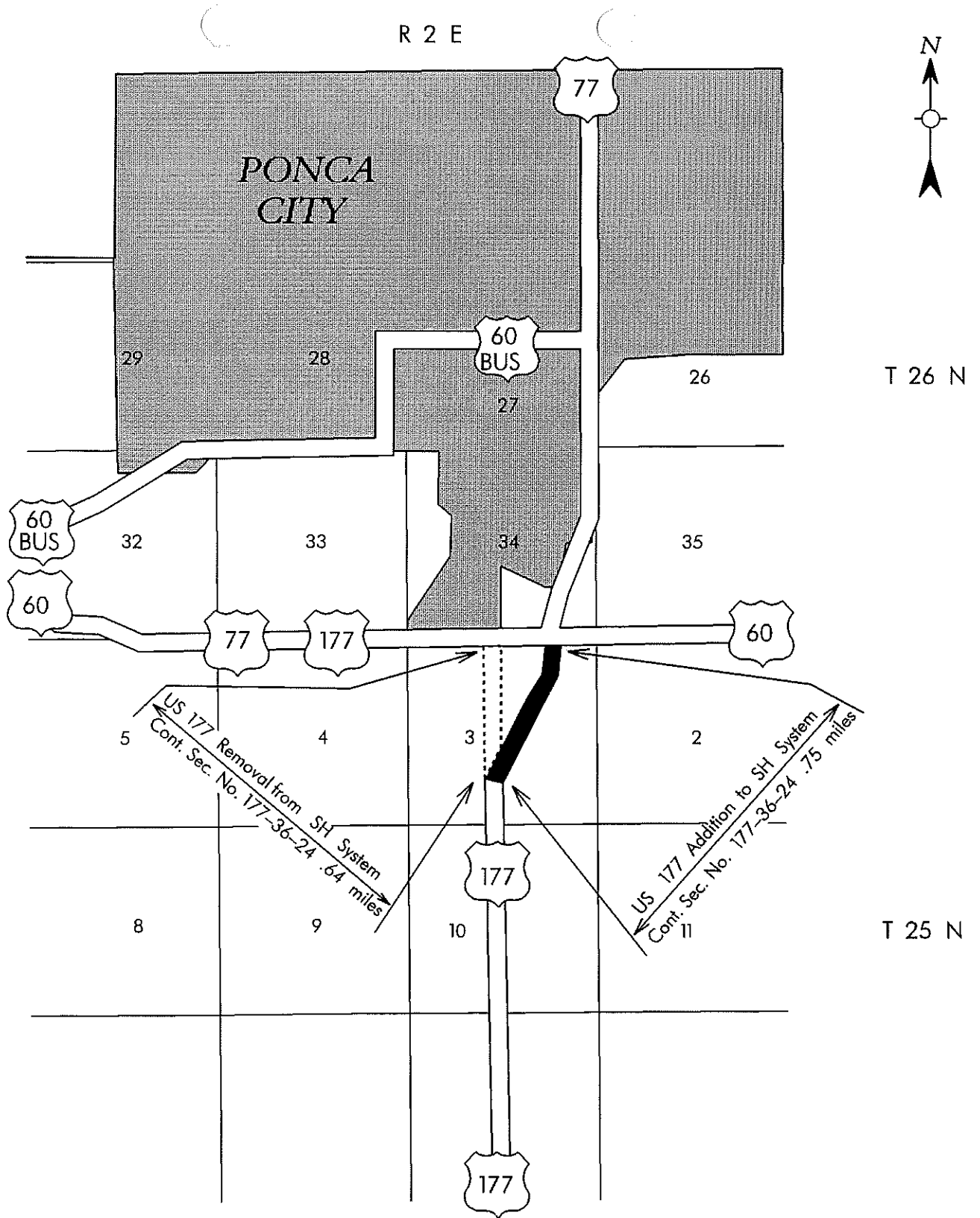
