Redesignation US Highway 56 - Cimarron and Texas Counties

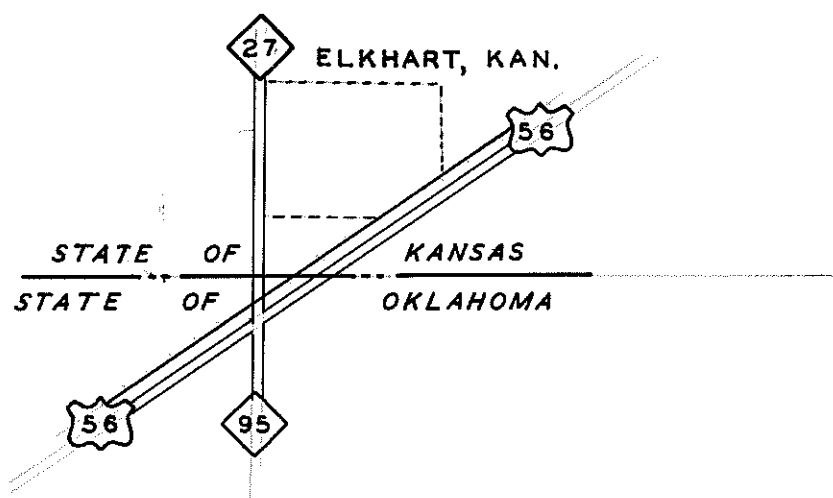
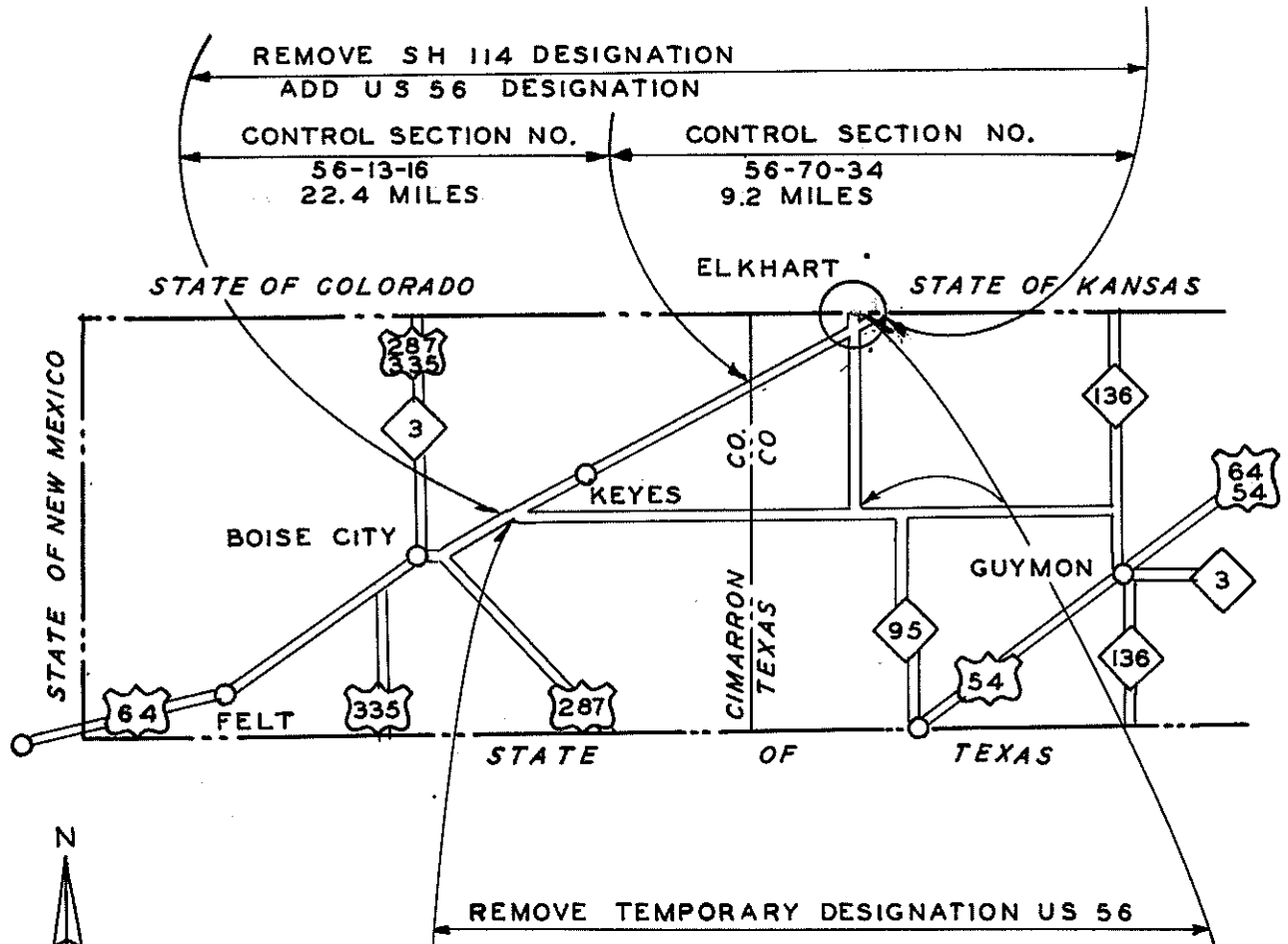

Remove temporary designation of US Highway 56 along US Highway 64 and State Highway 95 beginning northeast of Boise City and extending east and north to the Kansas State Line near Elkhart, Kansas.

Add US Highway 56 designation on a segment of road beginning at its junction with US Highway 64 northeast of Boise City and extending northeasterly to the Kansas State Line south of Elkhart, Kansas.

The Oklahoma State Highway Commission in regular session Nov. 6, 1961, Item 270 D, approved the following revision in the State Highway System.

Redesignation US Highway 56 - Cimarron and Texas Counties.

Remove State Highway 114 designation from a segment of road beginning at its junction with US Highway 64 northeast of Boise City and extending northeasterly to the Kansas State line near Elkhart, Kansas.

Remove temporary designation of US Highway 56 along US Highway 64 and State Highway 95 beginning northeast of Boise City and extending east and north to the Kansas State line near Elkhart, Kansas.

Add US Highway 56 designation on a segment of road beginning at its junction with US Highway 64 northeast of Boise City and extending northeasterly to the Kansas State line south of Elkhart, Kansas.

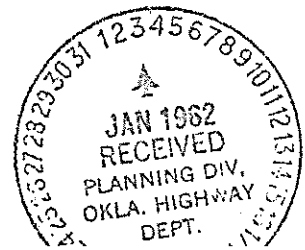
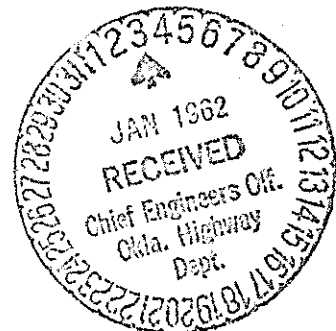
