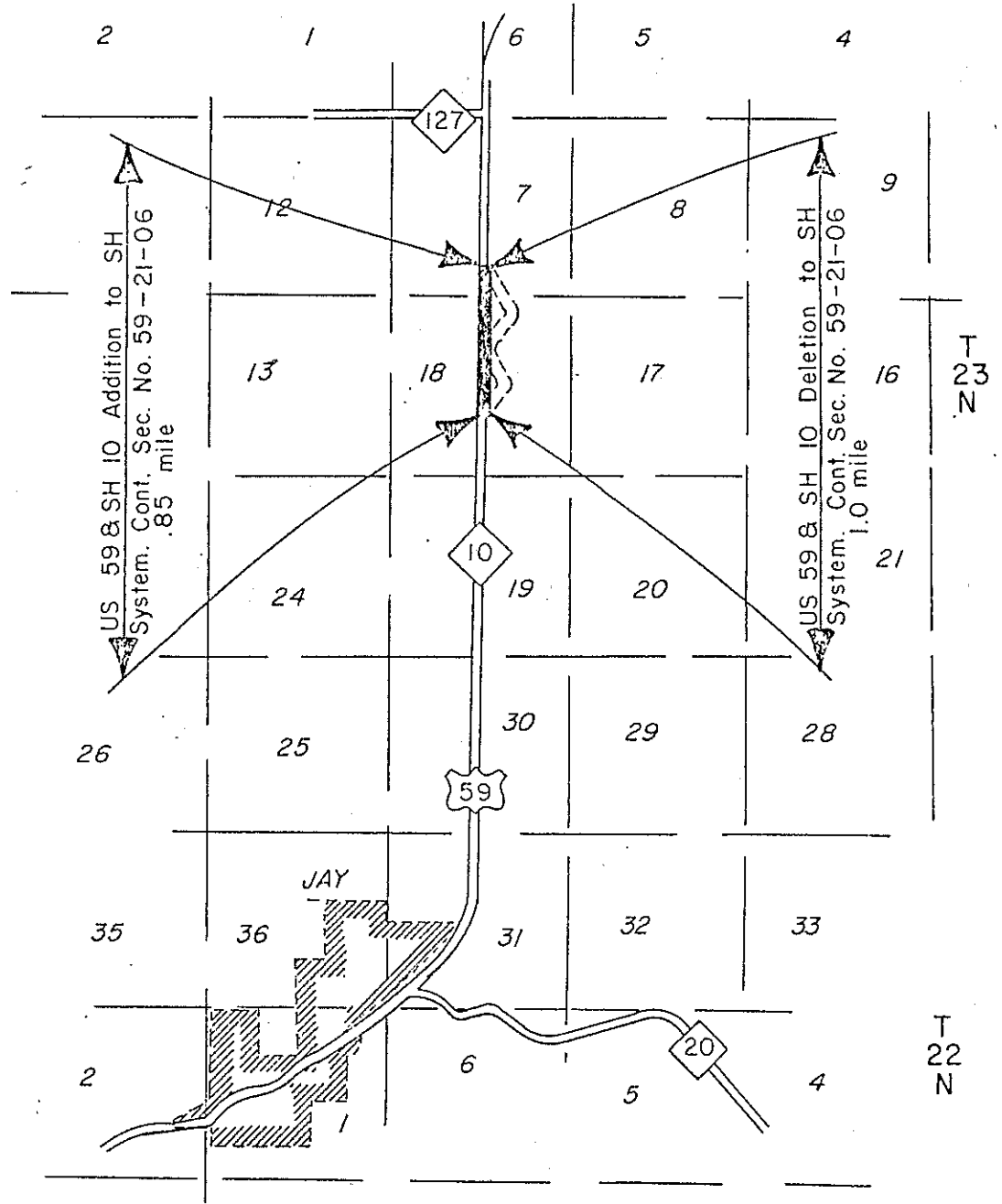
Relocation of U. S. 59 - Delaware County

Transfer from the State Highway System a segment of old road designated as U. S. Highway 59 beginning at its junction with the new road, approximately 4.0 miles north of Jay and extending northerly 1.0 mile to its junction with the new road. This segment of old road will be transferred to the local jurisdiction of Delaware County for further maintenance or abandonment.




Add to the State Highway System a segment of new road to be designated as U. S. Highway 59 beginning at its junction with the old road approximately 4.0 miles north of Jay and extending north to its junction with the old road a distance of 0.85 mile.

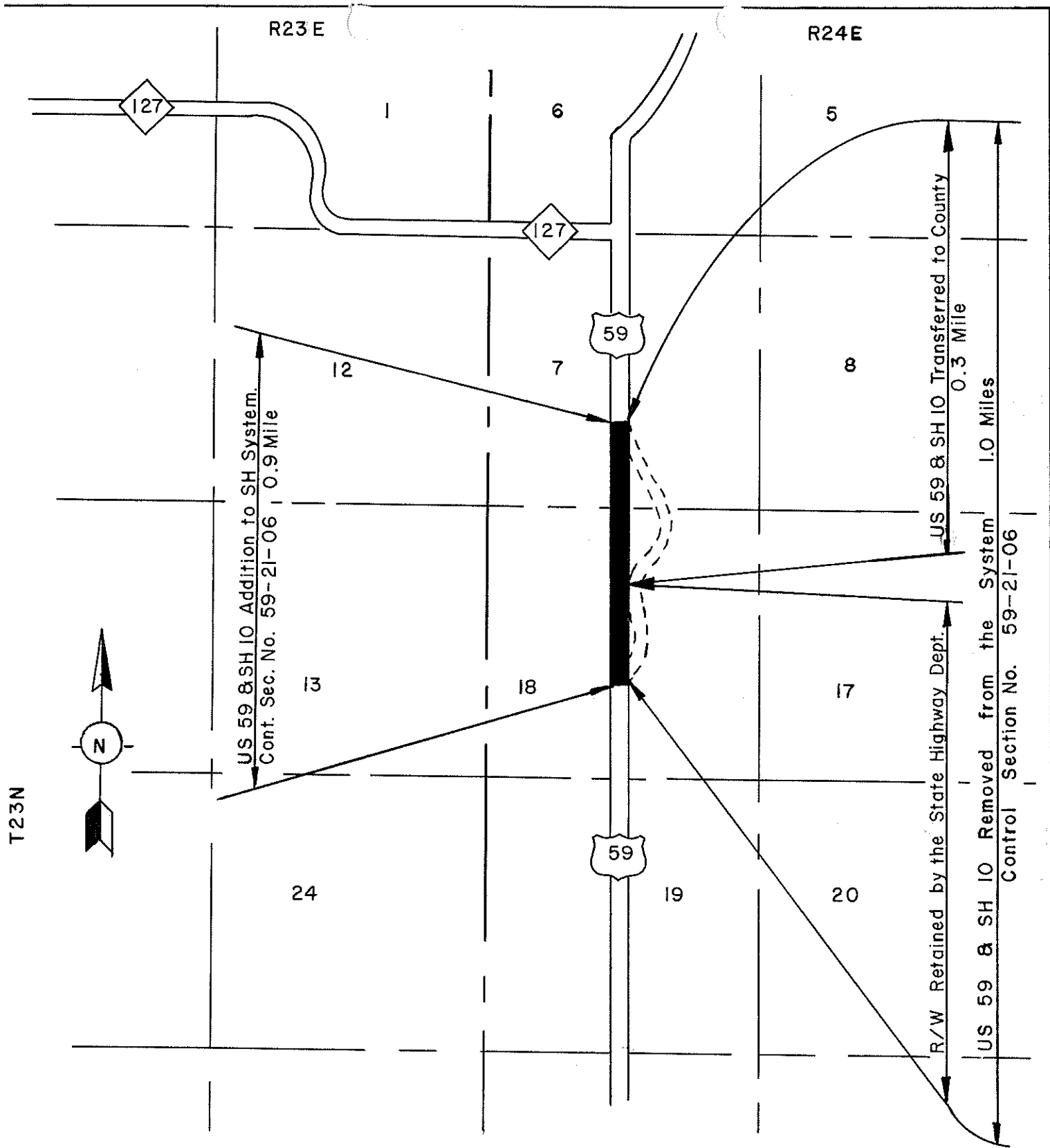
This segment of new road has been constructed as Federal-aid Project F-349(15).





US 59 & SH 10 Relocation
