✓ Minutes - Washita County

The Commission designated as part of the State Highway System a road beginning on State Highway 41 at the corner common to Sections 5 and 6, Township 9 North, Range 18 West, extending south 1.0 mile, thence east 0.45 mile, ending two blocks east of the main business street in Dill City, Washita County, total length of 1.45 miles, this highway to be designated as State Highway 42. The Commission also authorized the Engineering Department to prepare plans for surfacing this section with an oil mat or other type of bituminous surfacing. The base for this surface has already been constructed, and it is the Commission's understanding that nothing will be required except shaping of the roadbed and actual surfacing.
