Caddo County - Changes to State Highway System in Apache -
US 62 and US 281

That the Commission approve the following changes in the State Highway System due to the construction of Project S-680(5):

REMOVE FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM OLD US-62 - US 281:

Beginning at the intersection of Evans Street and Coblake Street in Apache, and extending east and northeast to SH 19, a distance of 0.77 mile, remove from the System and return to the city of Apache and Caddo County for maintenance.

ADD TO THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AS US-62 - US 281:

Beginning at the intersection of Evans and Coblake Streets, and extending northerly on Coblake to SH - 19, a distance of 0.36 mile.

ADD DESIGNATION:

From the junction of SH-19 and new US-62 - US-281 at Coblake Street, east along SH 19 to the northeast corner of Section 21; T5N, R11W, a distance of 0.57 mile, add designation only, of US-62 and US-281.
