SUBJECT: Revision to the State Highway System
Relocation US 62 - SH 10

COUNTY: Cherokee

This action is necessitated by the realignment of US 62 - SH 10 east of Tahlequah, Construction Project F-508(13).

Add to the State Highway System a segment of highway on new alignment to be designated US 62, beginning at a tie with the old facility and extending easterly 1.69 miles to a connection with the existing highway.

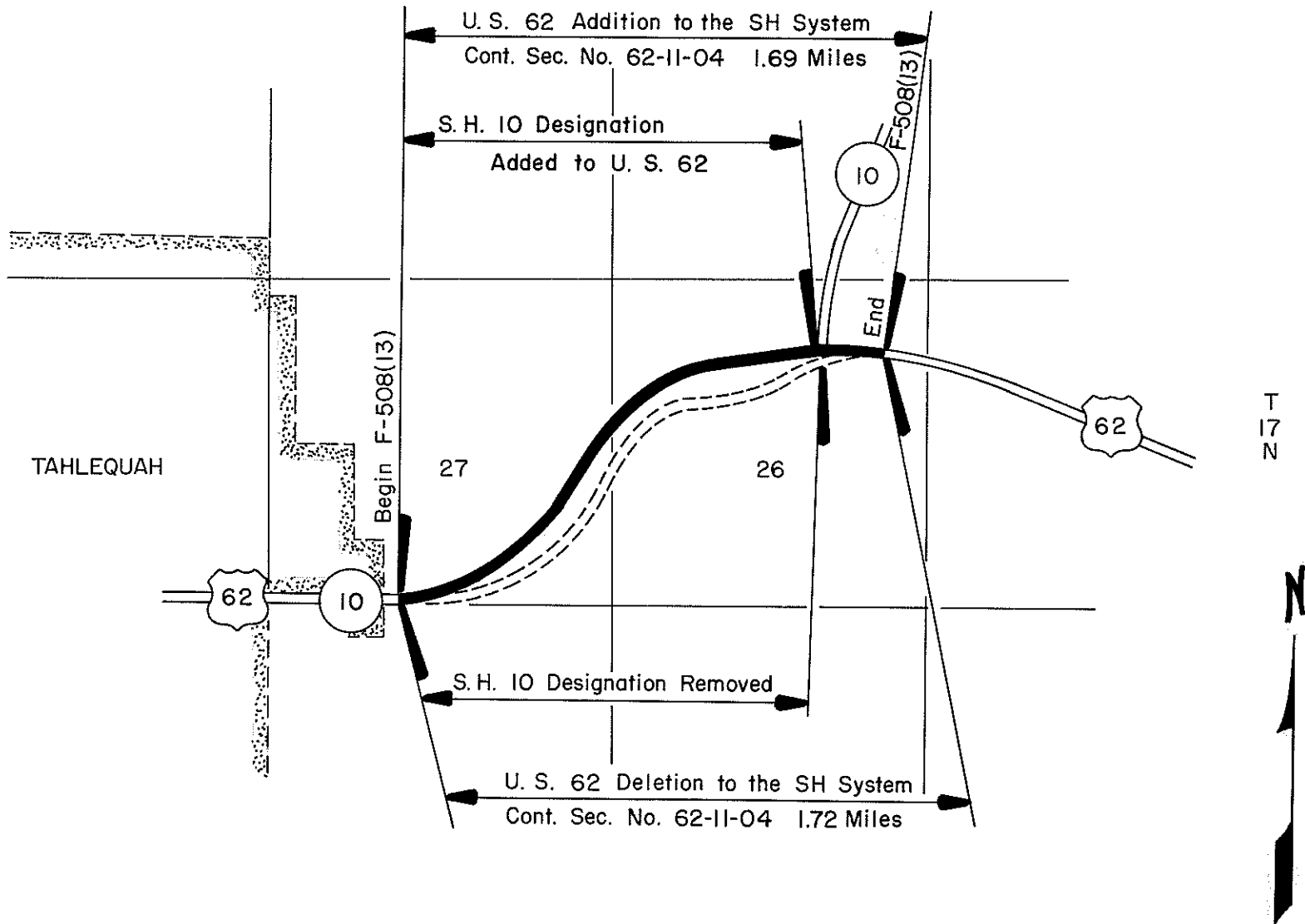
Add SH 10 designation to new US 62 beginning at the west end of the new construction easterly to the junction of existing SH 10.

Delete from the State Highway System 1.72 miles of old highway replaced by the new facility. This segment of old US 62 is returned to the appropriate local jurisdiction for further maintenance or abandonment. A Removal Public Hearing was held August 23, 1982 in accordance with State Law.




This action will become effective upon approval of the State Transportation Commission.
