SUBJECT: Revision to the State Highway System - Relocation SH 82 in Tahlequah
COUNTY: Cherokee

As a result of the completion of Construction Project MAM-3363(15), Tahlequah N. E. Bypass, the following actions are necessary to implement needed State Highway System revisions in the City of Tahlequah. At the present time, both the old highway and the new bypass carry SH 82 route markers.

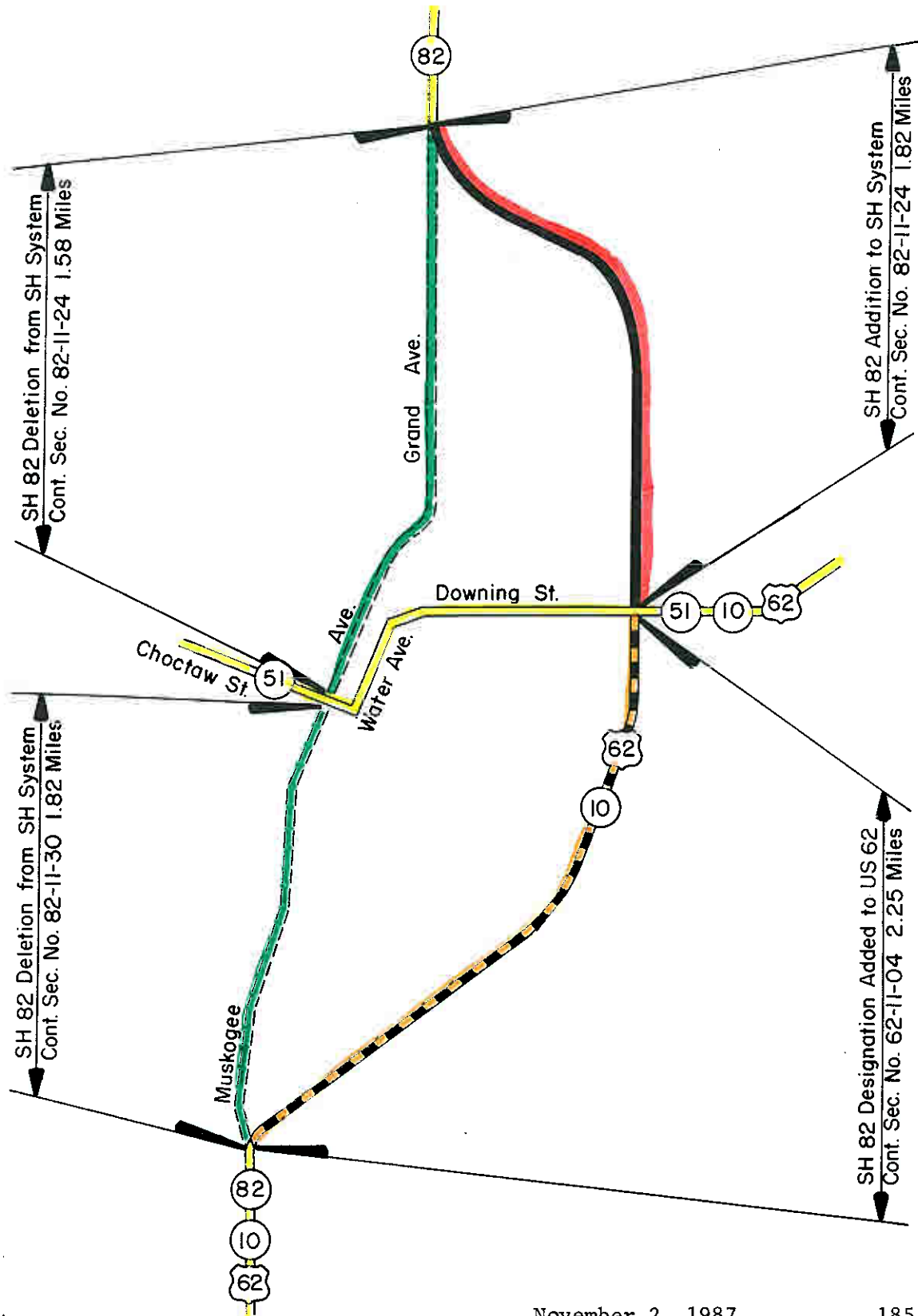
Add SH 82 designation to US 62 - SH 10, beginning at its junction with the old highway (Muskogee Avenue) and extending northeasterly to its junction with SH 51 (Downing Street), a distance of 2.25 miles.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of highway on new alignment to be designated SH 82, beginning at its junction with US 62 - SH 51 (Downing Street) and extending northwesterly to its junction with existing SH 82 (Grand Avenue), a distance of 1.82 miles.

Remove from the State Highway System 3.40 miles of old highway replaced by the new facility. This segment of old SH 82 is returned to the appropriate local jurisdiction for further maintenance or abandonment. A Removal Public Hearing was held October 21, 1987 in accordance with State law.

These actions will become effective upon approval by the State Transportation Commission.
