SUBJECT: Revision to the State Highway System

COUNTY: Oklahoma

These revisions are presented cooperatively by the Department and the City of Oklahoma City. These revisions will result in a simplified routing for through traffic and are consistent with plans to utilize the improvements to Shields Boulevard, upon their completion, as US 77.

Transfer from the State Highway System a segment of road designated as US Highway 77, beginning at Southwest 4th and Robinson Street and extending north on Robinson for 2.24 miles to the junction of Northwest 23rd and Robinson Street.

Transfer from the State Highway System a segment of road designated as US Highway 77, beginning at the junction of Southwest 5th and Broadway and extending north on Broadway for 0.27 mile to Reno Avenue and then east on Reno for 0.08 mile to the junction of E.K. Gaylord Boulevard.

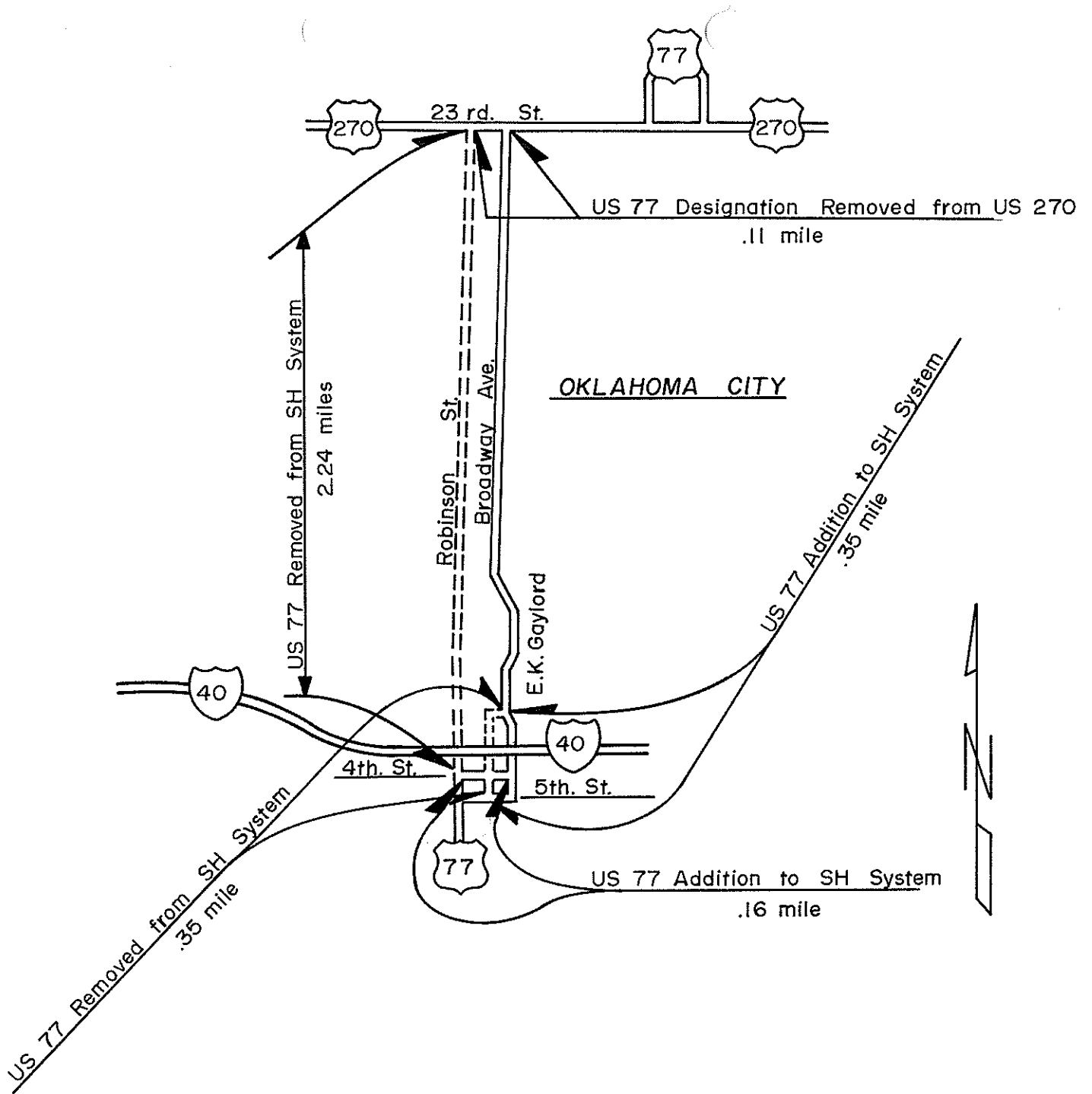
Remove US Highway 77 designation from Northwest 23rd Street (US 270), beginning at the intersection of Northwest 23rd and Robinson and extending east on Robinson for 0.11 mile to the intersection of Northwest 23rd and Broadway. A public hearing has been held on this removal, as required by law.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of road to be designated as US Highway 77, beginning at the junction of Southwest 4th and Robinson Street and extending east 0.16 mile to E.K. Gaylord Boulevard.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of road to be designated as US Highway 77, beginning at the junction of Southwest 5th and Broadway and extending east for 0.08 mile then north on E.K. Gaylord Boulevard for 0.27 mile to the junction of Reno Avenue and E.K. Gaylord Boulevard.

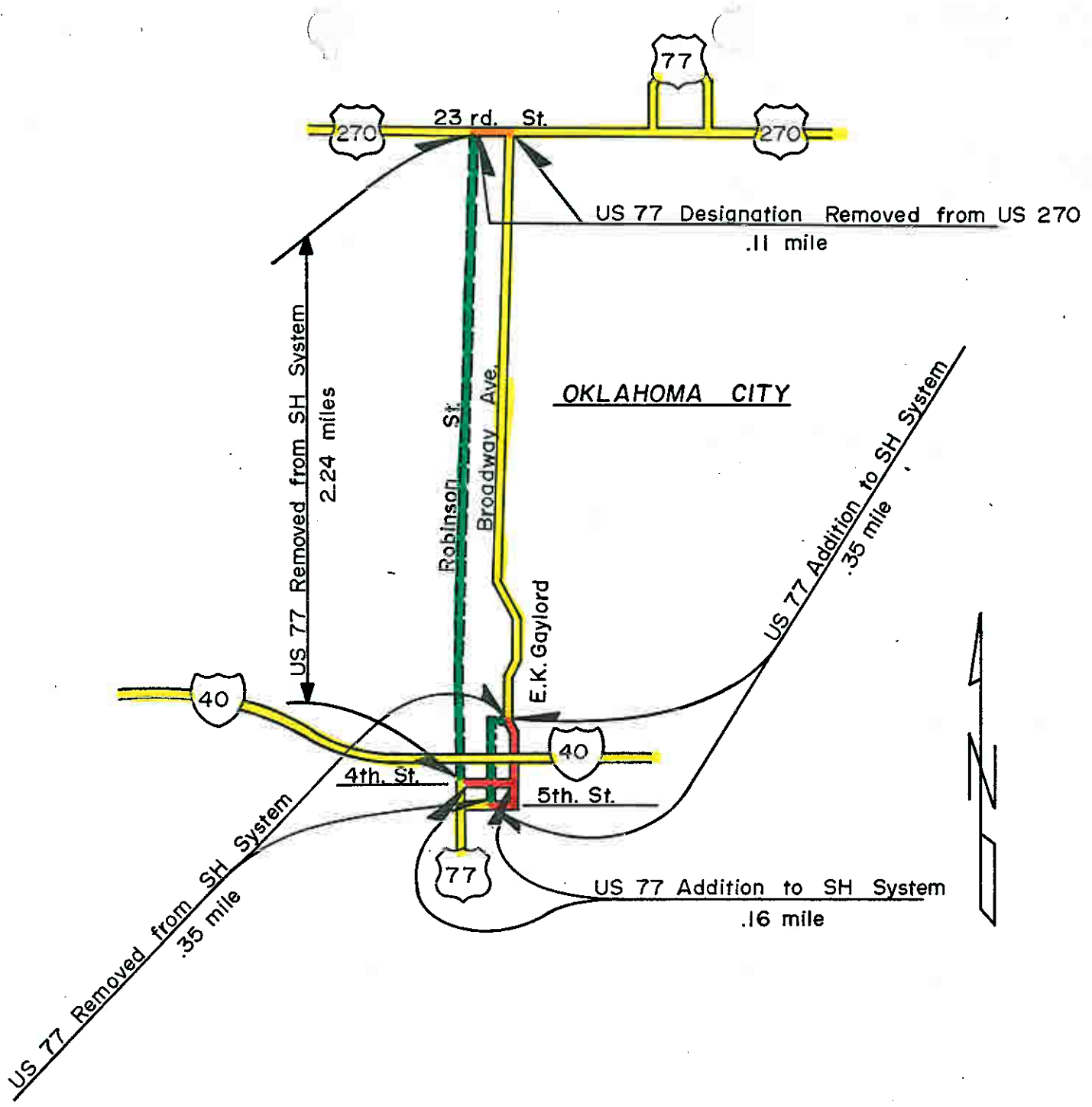
In the future the US 77 designation will be removed from the City street system and placed on the Central Expressway.


I hereby certify that in accordance with Section 503 of Title 69, O.S.1971, a public hearing was scheduled at:

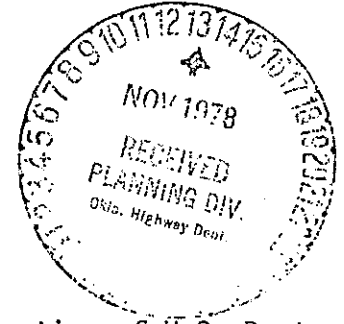
