SUBJECT: State Highway System
Cleveland County

That the Commission approve the following revision of the State Highway System:

Remove

US 77 Beginning at the intersection of Porter Avenue and Robinson Street in Norman and extending north and west on old US 77 through the town of Moore to the Junction with the new location of US 77 one mile north of Moore, a distance of 9.5 miles.

(K) SH 77 SH 77H beginning at Hollywood Corner and extending north seven miles to the Oklahoma County line to be removed upon completion of Project S-697 (2).

SH 74 SH 74 beginning at the intersection of the new location of US 77 Business Route two miles west of Norman on Robinson Street extended, thence east 0.5 mile and south one mile, a total distance of 1.5 miles.

Add

US 77 US 77 beginning at the intersection of old US 77 one mile north of Moore south and southeast on the new location to Robinson and Flood Street in Norman, thence east on Robinson Street to old US 77 on Porter Avenue, a total distance of 9.7 miles.

US 77 Business Route beginning at the intersection of the new location of US 77 three miles north and one and one-half miles west of Norman and extending south on the new location to Main Street extended, thence east on Main Street to Porter Avenue, a total distance of 7.1 miles.

SH 74 SH 74 beginning at the intersection of US 77 Business Route and SH 74 Robinson Street extended west of Norman south one mile to Main Street extended, thence east one-half mile to the present location of SH 74 west of Norman, a total distance of 1.5 miles.
