



## ODOT Requests Input on Public Transit

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation Transit Division will host six public meetings statewide November 17, 18 and 19 to receive input on transit programs and the funding application process associated with these programs.

ODOT is asking the public as well as representatives of public, private and non-profit transportation and human services providers to attend one of the meetings across the state to discuss and give input on services in their area. By hosting meetings at multiple locations, ODOT hopes to maximize participation in the development process.

The purpose of these meetings is to solicit feedback on services provided in areas and discuss the grant application process, so any modifications and improvements can be made to next year's application process. Specifically, ODOT is seeking input on recommended changes to the evaluation process, performance criteria and new application format.

Additionally, these meetings will provide the public an opportunity to obtain information on available funding in order to develop potential projects that may be eligible for funding through one or both of the Federal Transit Administration programs, the Jobs Access and Reverse Commute Program and the New Freedom Program.

In the months following the public input meetings, ODOT will host a series of training workshops in conjunction with the opening of the fiscal year 2010 grant application process.
