### December Transportation Commission Meeting

The Oklahoma Transportation Commission will hold a special meeting at **11 a.m. Monday, Dec. 8** in the R.A. Ward Transportation Building, 200 N.E. 21<sup>st</sup> St. in Oklahoma City. Items to be addressed at the meeting include:

- The commission is expected to vote on awarding the largest single construction contract in the history of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation for major work to reconstruct two I-35 interchanges in Norman.
- Commissioners will be asked to vote on whether to award a \$25 million contract for reconstruction of the I-40 bridges over the South Canadian River near the Canadian/Caddo county line.
- They are also expected to vote on contracts for major projects to reconstruct and widen more than two miles of US-77 in Slaughterville in Cleveland County and install cable barrier on 14 miles of US-69 in McIntosh County.
- Commissioners are expected to go into an executive session to discuss the salary of ODOT Executive Director Mike Patterson.

The commission, an eight-member panel appointed by the governor to oversee the state's transportation development, awards project contracts for road and bridge construction on a monthly basis. The meeting is open to the public.
