**SH-48, Okfuskee/Creek County**

**SH-48 closed south of Bristow through fall**

SH-48 is closed at the Deep Fork of the Canadian River near the Okfuskee/Creek county line through fall for bridge replacement.

Traffic is detoured west to SH-99 via US-62 and SH-66. Signs are in place.

In December, the Oklahoma Transportation Commission awarded a \$4.6 million contract with the Oklahoma City-based Sewell Bros., Inc., to replace the three bridges. The bridges cross the Deep Fork River and two overflow bodies.

The new bridges will replace three structures built in 1938 and carry about 1,500 vehicles each day.
