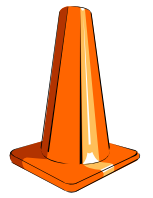

Oklahoma 2011, 2010, 2009 and National 2010 Statistics

Nationwide 2010 (most recent complete statistics)

- 🚧 In 2010, 576 people were killed in highway work zone collisions nationwide
- 🚧 This is down from 2009, when 680 people were killed in work zone collisions.

Oklahoma 2011

- 🚧 13 people were killed in Oklahoma highway work zones in 2011.
- 🚧 Also in 2011, 789 people were injured in 1,427 collisions in Oklahoma work zones, the second highest number of work zone collisions and greatest amount of injuries in the last decade.
- 🚧 This is a nearly 63% increase in fatalities and a 76% increase in the number of accidents in work zones since 2005.
- 🚧 The greatest number of collisions resulted from following too close, traveling at unsafe speeds and driver inattention.

Oklahoma 2010

- 🚧 18 people were killed in Oklahoma highway work zones in 2010.
- 🚧 782 people were injured in 1,466 collisions in Oklahoma work zones, the highest number of work zone collisions and greatest amount of injuries in the last decade.

Oklahoma 2009

- 🚧 18 people were killed in Oklahoma work zones in 2009
- 🚧 771 people were injured in 1,291 collisions
