**WELCOME CENTERS**

Oklahoma's 10 state-operated Welcome Centers are staffed with travel planners and counselors who can help make your ROAD TRIP a success. Free coffee and restrooms await visitors. Centers are open daily (except Christmas) 8:30 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. The State Capitol Information Center is open Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. State Capitol Tours are on the hour 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Weekend tours require advance reservations. Centers are located at these points of entry into the state and near major metropolitan areas.

**ARRIVING FROM THE NORTH.** On I-35, 10 miles south of the Oklahoma/Kansas border near Blackwell.

**ARRIVING FROM THE NORTHEAST.** Two locations: (1) On I-44, Will Rogers Turnpike, east of Miami. (2) On I-44, Will Rogers Turnpike, south of Vinita exit, on the westbound lower level of concession plaza (in McDonald's®).

**ARRIVING FROM THE EAST.** On I-40, 17 miles west of Oklahoma/Arkansas border, near Sallisaw.

**ARRIVING FROM THE SOUTH.** Two locations: (1) On US-69/75, two miles north of the Oklahoma/Texas border near Colbert. (2) On I-35, three miles north of the Oklahoma/Texas border near Thackerville.

**ARRIVING FROM THE SOUTHWEST.** On I-44, H.E. Bailey Turnpike, at the Elmer Graham Concession Plaza (in McDonald's®).

**ARRIVING FROM THE WEST.** On I-40, nine miles east of the Oklahoma/Texas border near Erick.

**OKLAHOMA CITY.** Two locations: (1) In the State Capitol at NE 23rd and Lincoln Boulevard. (2) At I-35 and NE 122nd.
